
# Calling for Holy Trinity Volunteers

Most of the individuals they serve are seniors who could not otherwise remain in their homes without the support of the meals provided by AID FOR FRIENDS.

### Who prepares the meals they deliver?

We do . . . along with other local churches and organizations. For many years, a small group of our parishioners, organized by Jeanette Der Hagopian, has been preparing nutritious meals, which are picked up by AID FOR FRIENDS and then lovingly distributed.
